

**Statement of Compliance with the Waste Directive EU/2008/98/EC and amendment EU/2018/851**

Yaskawa Nordic AB complies with the requirements of the Waste Framework Directive (2008/98/EC), as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/851, which aims to protect the environment and human health by preventing or reducing the generation of waste, minimizing the adverse impacts of waste management, and improving resource efficiency.

In accordance with the Directive, Yaskawa Nordic ensures that all waste-related activities are conducted in line with the waste hierarchy, including:

- Waste prevention
- Preparation for reuse
- Recycling
- Other recovery operations, such as energy recovery
- Disposal of waste in an environmentally acceptable manner

**SCIP Reporting and Registration of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)**

As required by Article 9(1)(i) of the Waste Directive and Article 33(1) of the REACH Regulation (EC 1907/2006), Yaskawa Nordic AB reports relevant information to the SCIP database maintained by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). This ensures transparency regarding the presence of SVHCs in articles throughout their lifecycle, including the waste phase.

Yaskawa Nordic AB designs and manufactures large industrial systems intended for permanent installation by professionals in industrial facilities. These systems are not subject to the WEEE Directive (2012/19/EU) and therefore do not require registration under WEEE.

However, in line with our commitment to regulatory compliance and environmental responsibility, we perform simplified SCIP registrations for products containing SVHCs above the threshold limit, ensuring that relevant material information is available to downstream users and waste operators.
